Main themes, education

Education Throughput: Drop-out first year bachelor students (M1); completion of BSc students within scheduled time (U5); completion of MSc students within scheduled time plus one year (U6; 60 % for 2013); volume in part-time education (U4)¹.

Employment of Graduates: better than national average (M2)

The use of building space: for teaching (U12)

Globalisation: global interaction, faculty (U25); global interaction/study abroad, students (U26)

Course evaluation: good evaluation scores (U39)

Job satisfaction: MTU (U40)

Main themes, research

External funding (M3, U30): Strengthening application process (U28, U29), Reduce time gap from grant to initiating research (U30) and Streamline research support (candidate for U13?)

Job satisfaction: career paths (U33, U34), library (U15), labs and IT (U16, U22) and MTU (U40)

Moving up reputation spiral: Publishing (U27), Ph.D. graduates (U36)

Deliver on mission: Strategic areas (U32, U31)
