

The time and activity schedule of the target has been kept.







The time and activity schedule of the target has not been kept. However, it is still estimated that the target can be reached within the period as the delays are not critical.

S1	By the end of 2013 at least two proposals for strategic research areas have been "positively evaluated" and will continue in 2014.	It is uncertain whether two proposals for strategic research areas will have received a positive evaluation by the end of 2013. However, it is possible. Hence the status is indicated as yellow. The research area 'Energy Futures' has been positively evaluated. The 'GI-RI' research area will be evaluated later in 2013. More proposals are under way.		Jørgen Staunstrup
S2	At least 18 PhD students will graduate during 2013.	Status after second quarter 2013: 13 PhD's have graduated, three theses have been handed in, and further seven students are planning to hand in their theses and graduate before the end of the year.		Jens Chr. Godskesen



S3	The IT University will insource EBUSS (cand.it. E-business or DIM) from the fall of 2013.	The curriculum is approved, teachers are appointed, applicants have applied and students will be admitted 1 September 2013.		Kasper Østerbye
S4	In 2013 at least 40 percent of the thesis students carry out their thesis projects in groups.	Status after second quarter 2013: The share of thesis students carrying out their thesis in groups is currently 38 %.		Kasper Østerbye
S5	Examination Forms A1 and A2 as hand-written exams are phased out during 2013 as ordinary examination forms.	New exam forms were approved by The Study Board in April 2013. The new exam forms are replacing the former exam forms A1 and A2 which will not exist from Autumn 2013.		Lene Rehder
S6	During 2013 a least three workflows that are at least partly manual are digitalised.	The following processes are under digitalisation in the departments: Overhead and Liquidity and Personal Administrative System (PAS). With PAS in itself eight processes will be digitalised during 2013. Other processes are also being scrutinised, such as the PhD sheet and Booking of meetings.		Henrik Ejby and Iben Vitved Bruhn
