Target	Description	Comments	Status
S1	At least three candidate strategic areas will be "positively evaluated" in 2014 and continue in 2015.	Three strategic research areas, Energy Futures, Critical Systems and DECIDIS, are developed and they are positively evaluated by the Department Management at the end of 2014. The three areas have been approved for funding and will continue in 2015.	
S2	Before the end of 2014, the quality of at least three workflows in research, education or administration has been improved through digitalisation, for example, digital registration of research applications and projects, absence sheets or "datablanketter". In addition the effects of at least three recently implemented projects will be measured.	The quality of three recently implemented projects, ScanPas, LearnIT and Faculty Roster, have been evaluated. The evaluations show, that those three workflows have been improved through digitalisation. For all five relevant projects started under the Project Portfolio Group in 2014, a description of how a baseline is established and how effects will be measured is included in the project description.	

S3	Before the end of 2014, at least two formal experiments with new educational models for education should have been carried out and documented.	Two projects were carried out in 2014. The projects are documented and the Executive Management has approved the documentation.	
S4	During 2014, the IT University will conduct an external evaluation of its MSc programme Digital Design and Communication.	The IT University has made a self-evaluation report for the external evaluation panel. Following the evaluation of the MSc programme Digital Design and Communication, the external evaluation panel released their evaluation report in September 2014.
